  - Coordination w/Police, Guards, Hours, Offenders, Participant Lists, Queuing, Rules and Staffing

- Work on the design now through presentation on January 14, 2013
- Separate Use Permit process to follow
  - Will include public input w/Planning Commission & County Board
  - Hearing likely in March
- Construction of lower floors to begin June 2013
- Center projected to begin operations in fall of 2014
