Canopy trees



Shingle oak:
shiny dark green leaves, russet fall color and a pyramidal form.
Hgt: 40-60' Spread: 40-60'



American yellowwood:
fragrant white flowers in late spring, yellow fall color and smooth grey bark
Hgt: 30-45' Spread: 40-45'

Rain Garden Plants



Allegheny Serviceberry - small tree
white flowers in early spring, red berries in
summer, red fall color



Winterberry 'Red Sprite' - shrub
tiny white spring flowers become dark red fall berries.
Berries persist after the leaves fall. Hgt=2-3'



Smooth white beardtongue:
white flowers in late spring. Hgt=3-4'



Smooth blue aster:
lavender-blue flowers in late
summer and early fall. Hgt=3-4'



Obedient plant 'Vivid':
bright pink flowers in late sum-
mer and early fall. Hgt=3-4'



Short-toothed mountain mint:
white or lavender flowers in mid-
late summer. Hgt=2-3'



Purple coneflower:
pink-purple flowers in summer.
Hgt=2-5'



Sea oats:
Clumping grass with green seedheads,
turning golden in fall. Hgt=2-5'
